GOALS

Building on previous Think Tank Meetings and Stakeholder Dialogues $\dot{},$

- further identify, specify and capture appropriate response measures at various levels, including forest management, policy, industry and science, to address future and diverse demands on forests:
- identify opportunities for shaping drivers and barriers advancing or hindering the implementation of response measures; and
- propose next steps to address these drivers and barriers
- identify who can take these decisive steps;
- share insights of preliminary findings of IUFRO-Mondi synthesis study on the future of forest goods and services in Europe

BACKGROUND

The IUFRO-Mondi Partnership is a science business platform that aims to better understand climate change impacts on forests and identify response measures in line with the Sustainable Development Goals.

There is increased scientific and empirical evidence that forests in Europe are significantly impacted by climate change-induced disturbances with far-reaching consequences. Demands on forests, including wood, biodiversity, carbon and energy, have never been higher and more diverse.

In addition to climate change and biological production, factors related to changes in people's perception of forests, government policies and geopolitical consideration, will have significant impact on the future of forests in Europe. Forest management, innovation and technology will further influence future pathways.

At this Think Tank Meeting a consortium of senior scientists will kick off the discussion by presenting preliminary findings of a comprehensive synthesis study on the future of goods and services from pan–European forests. The study addresses aspects and response options which will shape the future of wood supply in Central and Northern Europe. Business representatives will present pressing challenges, current adaptation strategies and information needs.
